## **CLC Behavior Agreement**

At COA, we believe that YOU can succeed, and it is our job to help you to learn, grow, and have fun! Therefore, we have high expectations of you. We will work as a team to help you meet those expectations, and learn from your mistakes when you struggle. We will also model these behaviors for you, because we – youth and adults – are all held to the same expectations.

## As a participant at COA/ CLC programs, I agree to:

- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Treat everyone with respect.
- Respect all materials & equipment in the center, including the property of others.
- Keep my hands to myself.
- Respect the feelings & ideas of others.
- ★ Have a positive attitude.
- **★** Be honest.
- ★ Listen actively and follow staff directions the first time.
- ★ Take responsibility for my words and actions.
- Stay with my group and ask permission to leave the room/activity

I understand that I have the power to make positive choices and succeed. I understand that if I follow the expectations above, I will be a positive member of my community, and learn, grow, and have fun at COA. I understand that there will be consequences if I struggle to follow expectations and/or take responsibility for my words and actions. Consequences may include: sitting out of activities/field trips, temporary suspension, and dismissal from the program. I understand that if I am physically aggressive, or leave my group and refuse to return, I may be dismissed from the program immediately.

With the exception of physical aggression, all incidents will be handled on a 3-incident system:

- ★ 1<sup>st</sup> Incident: Verbal warning
- **★ 2<sup>nd</sup> Incident**: Written warning and parent contact
- **★** 3<sup>rd</sup> Incident: 1-3 day suspension and parent meeting

More than three incidents will be subject to youth dismissal from the program, or half-day (AM or PM) attendance. Management reserves the right to dismiss a child from program if the child's behavior is disruptive to the program and/or compromises the safety of themselves, other children and/or staff. Parents/guardians are responsible for arranging pick up if a child is dismissed from programming. Children suspended or terminated from the program will not qualify for a refund, and may not be eligible to participate in future programs. By signing, I agree to the terms of this behavior contract
